7 Resolution of Status (Class CD) visa

- (1) For item 1127AA of Schedule 1 to the Regulations, an application for a Resolution of Status (Class CD) visa must be made using form 1364 (Internet) through ImmiAccount.
- (2) If an officer of the Department has written to the applicant authorising the applicant to make the visa application using form 1364, an application for a Resolution of Status (Class CD) visa cannot be made in accordance with subsection (1), it may be made using form 1364 and posted with sufficient prepaid postage to:
